THE CORPORATION OF THE T O W N O F P E L H A M

BY-LAW #971 (1985)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #535 (1979), as amended, being a by-law to regulate and govern the installation of watermains, water services, water meters and remote readers in all areas of the Town of Pelham, and to fix rates and charges for the installation of same and for the water thereby supplied, and to provide for the management thereof.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary to increase the water rates to those buildings which are furnished with water by the Town of Pelham;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT Schedule "A" to By-law #535 (1979) be amended by deleting "10%" and substituting "5%" in its place.
- (2) THAT Schedule "A" to By-law #535 (1979) be amended by adding the following under Section 6 -

"Section 6 - Administration charge on "Not Sufficient Funds" chaques - \$5.00 plus actual bank charges."

- (3) THAT Schedule "C" to By-law #535 (1979) be amended by deleting Section 1 in its entirety and substituting the following:
- "1. New Water Meters & Remote Readers
 The capital contribution to the Town for water meters and remote readers with the Town retaining ownership shall be as follows:
 - (a) 19.05mm (3/4") \$125.00 Flat Rate
 - (b) 25.4mm (1") ---- \$185.00 Flat Rate
 - (c) 38.1mm (1 1/2") \$345.00 Flat Rate
 - (d) 50.9mm (2") --- \$400.00 Flat Rate

Charges are for supply of meter and remote reader only. Homeowner or agent are responsible for installation of meter and remote reader."

- (4) THAT Schedule "C" to By-law #535 (1979) be amended by deleting Section 2 in its entirety and substituting the following:
 - "2. Conversion to Remote Reader -
- Town to provide new 19.05mm metric water meter, remote control and wire and install water meter by Town forces with homeownr installing remote control and wire for above noted meter - \$125.00.

For all other sized meters, a deposit will be made equal to the estimated capital cost of the meter with the final cost to be calculated on a cost plus basis taking into consideration material, labour, equipment and 10% overhead."

THAT Schedule "C" to By-law #535 (1979) be amended by deleting "\$15.00" in Section 3 (a) and 3 (b) where it appears and by adding "\$25.00" $\,$ in its place.
