THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW #1004 (1985)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #104 (1971), being a by-law to provide for the collection and disposal of garbage, ashes and other refuse.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and adviseable to amend By-law #104 (1971);

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT Section 1 be amended by the addition of the following: Dangerous materials or substances such as poisons, acids, caustics, infected materials, explosives, radioactive materials or any other substances which environmental problems."
- THAT Section 5 (a) be amended by adding "or plastic bags" (2) after the word "containers" in Paragraph 1.
- (3) THAT Section 5 (a) be amended by adding the following as paragraph 3:

"Every plastic bag shall be securely tied to prevent spillage, and be of sufficient thickness to eliminate tearing, and the weight of the contents shall not cause breakage of the bag."

- THAT Section 9 (a) be amended by adding "persons" after "the" (4) in the first line.
- (5) THAT Sections 13 and 14 be renumbered "14" and "15" respectively and that the following new Section 13 be added:
 - "13. Prohibition -
 - (i) No person shall pickover, interfere with, disturb, remove or scatter any garbage, ashes or rubbish or any article placed out for collection or otherwise.
 - (ii) Subsection (i) does not apply to prevent collection personnel from carrying out their duties."
