

TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 102 (1971)

A By-law to authorize an agreement with certain municipalities for the joint management and operation of a land fill disposal site.

WHEREAS by-laws may be passed by the councils of all municipalities for entering into agreement with one or more municipalities to provide for the joint management and operation of garbage collection and disposal systems pursuant to Paragraph 5 of Section 377 of The Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249) and for the establishment of joint boards of management therefor;

AND WHEREAS it has been proposed that the Corporations of the Town of Grimsby, the Town of Lincoln, the Town of Pelham and the Township of West Lincoln should enter into an agreement for the purpose of the joint management and operation of a land fill disposal site for the disposal of garbage and an agreement for that purpose and for the establishment of a joint board of management is required;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM enacts as follows:

1. That an agreement to be dated the 1st day of June, 1971, and made between the Corporation of the Town of Grimsby, the Corporation of the Town of Lincoln, the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and the Corporation of the Township of West Lincoln for the purpose of the joint management and operation of a land fill disposal site for the disposal of garbage and for the establishment of a joint board of management of the same be and the same is hereby authorized.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk be and each of them is hereby authorized to execute the said agreement and the Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto and to deliver the same.
3. That one member of the council be appointed by resolution from time to time to represent the Corporation on the said board of management.


4. That a copy of the said agreement when executed by all parties shall be attached to and shall form part of this by-law.
