## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW #1040 (1985)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #966 (1984), a by-law imposing interim controls.

WHEREAS the Planning Act, S.O. 1983, Chapter 1, Section 37, Subsection 2 provides as follows: -

> "The Council of the municipality may amend an interim control by-law to extend the period of time during which it will be in effect, provided the total period of time does not exceed two years from the date of the passing of the interim control by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham considers it desirable to extend the existing Interim Control By-law #966 (1984) for a period of one year;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT Section 2 of By-law #966 (1984) be deleted in its entirety and be replaced with the following: -

> "This by-law shall be in force and effect until the 11th. day of December, 1986, unless repealed earlier by Council."
