

THE CORPORATION OF THE
T O W N O F P E L H A M
BY-LAW #1048 (1986)

Being a by-law to appoint certain officers of
the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Police Act, R.S.O. 1980 provides that municipalities may appoint one or more municipal law enforcement officers who shall be peace officers for the purpose of enforcing the by-laws of the municipality;


AND WHEREAS the Tile Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1980 provides that municipalities borrowing money under the Act shall employ an inspector of drainage;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Mr. Gordon White be and is hereby appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the purpose of the enforcement of Section 147 of the Highway Traffic Act, Chapter 198, R.S.O. 1980 to carry out the duties as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
2. THAT Mr. Dale Minor be and is hereby appointed as Tile Drainage Inspector to carry out the duties as set out in Schedule "B" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
