BY-LAW #1068 (1986)

Being a by-law to authorize the Mayor & Clerk to enter into an Encroachment Agreement with Keith & Velma Crick to permit the encroachment of a portion of a verandah onto Pelham Street.

WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to enter into an encroachment agreement with Keith & Velma Crick to permit the encroachment of a portion of a restaurant municipally known as 1502 Pelham Street in the Town of Pelham onto the road allowance of the Town;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That the Encroachment Agreement attached hereto and made part of this by-law between the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and Keith & Velma Crick be and the same is hereby approved.
- (2) THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and each of them is hereby authorized and instructed on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham to execute the said Encroachment Agreement and the Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
