THIS AGREEMENT made in triplicate this 3rd. day of November, 1986 A.D.

BETWEEN:

## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM Hereinafter called the "Town"

- and -

## LEO JOSEPH LAFLAMME

Hereinafter called the "Owner"

WHEREAS the Owner purports to be the Owner of the subject lands described in Schedule "A" attached to this Agreement;

AND WHEREAS the Owner is desirous of obtaining a potable water supply;

AND WHEREAS the Town has agreed to allow the Owner to obtain a municipal water supply by constructing a 25mm diameter water lateral on that portion of Sumbler Road as shown on Schedule "B" to this agreement, subject to certain terms and conditions;

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH that in consideration of the covenants herein contained the Town and the Owner covenant and agree as follows:

- (1) The Town will permit the Owner to connect to the existing watermain located on the south side of Sumbler Road approximately 210 metres west of the City of Welland municipal boundary, provided that the Owner shall construct, at his own expense, a 25mm copper lateral watermain from the existing main to the lot line of the lands described in Schedule "A" and a water meter chamber where required by the Town. The waterline shall be located as shown on the sketch attached hereto and marked as Schedule "B" to this Agreement.
- The Owner, at his own expense, shall construct a 38mm or 50mm diameter PVC 160 PSI pipe water service from the lot line of his property to service the existing single family dwelling located on the lands described in Schedule "A". There shall be no joints in the water service from its connection with the water meter to its connection with the interior plumbing system of the single family dwelling.

- (3) The Owner further agrees to pay for the cost of a water meter and all the water bills as levied from time to time by the municipality.
- The Owner further agrees that in the event that the Town of Pelham Council deems it advisable to extend the water service westerly along Sumbler Road, the Owner will not object to this extension and will further agree to pay all fair costs assessable to his property due to the extension.
- (5) This Agreement is to be binding on the Owner, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors, assigns forever and shall be registered against the title of the Owner as described in Schedule "A".
