Being a by-law to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to enter into an Agreement with Her Majesty The Queen, in right of Canada, represented by the Minister of Public Works RE: Postal Kiosks

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it desirable to enter into an agreement with Her Majesty the Queen, in right of Canada, represented by the Minister of Public Works, with regard to the installation of postal kiosks in the Town of Pelham;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the Agreement attached hereto and made part of this by-law between the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and Her Majesty the Queen, in right of Canada, represented by the Minister of Public Works, be and the same is hereby approved.
- (2) THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and each of them is hereby authorized and instructed on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham to execute the said Agreement and the Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
