THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW #1134 (1987)

Being a by-law to close and stop up part of the original road allowance between Concessions 9 & 10, Town of Pelham

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Pelham, hereinafter called the Corporation, that the original unopened road allowance set out and described in Schedule "A" attached thereto be closed and stopped up;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in the Pelham Herald, a newspaper published weekly in the Town of Pelham;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by its counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT upon and after the passing of this by-law all that portion of the 66 foot allowance for the road set out and described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, be and the same is hereby closed and stopped up.
