THE CORPORATION OF THE T O W N O F P E L H A M

BY-LAW NO. 1148 (1987)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #57 (1970), a by-law to regulate the discharge of firearms within the limits of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and advisable to amend By-law #57 (1970), as amended;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT Section 1 of By-law #57 (1970) is hereby amended by deleting the metes and bounds description of Area #3 in its entirety and adding the following in its place:
 - "(1) Commencing at the intersection of the centre line of Memorial Drive and the centre line of Balfour Street;

THENCE Easterly along the centre line of Memorial Drive to its intersection with the centre line of Cream Street;

THENCE Southerly along the centre line of Cream Street to a point 500 feet north of Canboro Road;

THENCE North-easterly along a line parallel to and 500 feet north of Canboro Road to a point in the easterly limit of Lot 4 in the 8th. Concession;

THENCE South along the said east limit of Lot 4 to a point 500 feet south of Canboro Road;

THENCE South-westerly along a line parallel to and 500 feet south of Canboro Road to its intersection with the centre line of Balfour Street;

THENCE North along the centre line of Balfour Street to the place of beginning."

- (2) THAT Section 4 of By-law #57 (1970), as amended, be deleted in its entirety and the following substituted in its place:
 - "(4) That the discharge of any firearm within the distance of One Thousand Feet (1,000') from any building used for raising of poultry for commercial purposes and within the distance of Five Hundred Feet (500') from any other type of building is prohibited."
