BY-LAW NO. 1157 (1987)

Being a by-law to dedicate a one foot reserve,  
being Part 1, Plan 59R-5417, as public highway.

WHEREAS Council considers it desirable to dedicate, as  
a public highway, the public lands herein described;

AND WHEREAS the said lands are now situate in the Town  
of Pelham;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE  
TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1)            THAT Part 1 on Reference Plan 59R-5417 be dedicated for  
the use of the public as a public highway.

(2)            THAT the public highway described in Section (1) be  
named "Pelham Town Square".

(3)            THAT By-law #805 (1982) be and is hereby repealed.
