

THE CORPORATION OF THE

BY-LAW NO. 1163 (1987)

Being a by-law to dedicate a one foot reserve
Lot 422, Plan M-19, and a portion of the road
allowance between Concessions 9 & 10, Town of
Pelham as public highway.

WHEREAS Council considers it desirable to dedicate as a
public highway the public lands herein described;

AND WHEREAS the said lands are now situate in the Town
of Pelham;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Lot 422, according to Registered Plan M-19, and
that part of the road allowance between Concessions 9 & 10, in
the former Township of Pelham, now in the Town of Pelham, lying
between the northerly productions of the easterly and westerly
limits of Milburn Drive according to Plan 59M-128 be and are
hereby opened and dedicated for the use of the public as a public
highway.

2. THAT the public highway described in Section 1 be named
"Milburn Drive".
