THE CORPORATION OF THE

TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NUMBER __118 (1971)

Being a By-law to authorize the undertaking of certain works to replace and improve existing water service connections to the existing Fonthill water distribution system.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham has determined that it is desirable to undertake certain works to replace and improve some existing water service connections to the Fonthill water distribution system.

AND WHEREAS under Section 379, Sub-section 1, Paragraph 52, of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249, by-laws may be passed by Councils of local municipalities for authorizing the completion, improvement, alteration, enlargement or extension of any public utility undertaking or any part of parts thereof, owned by the Corporation and controlled and managed by the Council or a public utility commission and for issuing debentures therefore;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AS A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. That the Town of Pelham do replace all existing defective water services consisting of lead and galvanized iron material, with new 3/4 inch diameter soft copper water service pipe and appurtance as recommended by the Town Engineer and the Town Works Superintendent.
- 2. That the Town Engineer do forthwith, prepare such plans and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the water service pipe replacement and that such works be carried on and be executed under the superintendence and according to the directions of the said Town Engineer.
- 3. That the total cost of the said works, which is estimated to be \$40,000.00, be recovered by means of revenue from the retail sale of water from the Fonthill water distribution.
- 4. That the Treasurer, subject to the approval of the Council, may agree with any bank or person for temporary financing to meet the cost of the said works pending the completion thereof,
- 5. That debentures be issued, for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the works when completed by the Regional Municipality of Niagara and shall bear interest at the rate to be determined by the Council and shall be payable in Ten (10) years on the installment plan.

6. That the amounts of principal and interest and any other amounts required to retire the said debentures shall be charged to and payable by the Corporation of the Town of Pelham pursuant to subsection 1 of Section 57 of the Regional Municipality of Niagara Act, 1968-69.
