THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 1188 (1988)

Being a by-law to amend By-law #1180 (1988), a by-law to impose interim control on certain lands within the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham has received an application to remove the Interim Control provisions from a portion of Lot 177 known municipally as 1064 Line Avenue to permit the construction of an addition of approximately 46 square metres to an existing single family dwelling;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham has determined that the removal of the said lands from Interim Control will not prejudice the proposed development of those lands as shown on Schedule "A" of By-law #1180 (1988);

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT Schedule "A" to By-law #1180 (1988) be amended by deleting those lands as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
- (2) THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the final day of passing.
