## THE CORPORATION OF THE T O W N O F P E L H A M

BY-LAW NO. 1215 (1988)

Being a by-law to prohibit the burning of leaves within certain areas of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS Section 104 of the Municipal Act provides that Council may pass by-laws and make regulations for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality in matters not specifically provided for by the Municipal Act as may be deemed expedient and are not contrary to law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and advisable to prohibit the burning of leaves in certain areas of the Town of Pelham in order to protect the inhabitants of these areas from medical problems resulting from the exposure to the smoke generated by the burning of leaves;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

## (1) In this by-law:

- (a) "By-law Enforcement Officer" shall mean that person or persons appointed by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham for the purposes of enforcing Town by-laws, and shall include any Police Officer, the Fire Chief and Fire Prevention Officer employed by the Town of Pelham.
- (2) THAT the burning of leaves shall be prohibited in those areas of the Town of Pelham as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto and made part of this by-law.

Every person who contravenes any provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence, and, upon conviction, is liable to a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for the first offence and not more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for the second or subsequent offences.
