THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 1304 (1989)

Being a by-law to regulate the use of lands and the character and use of buildings and structures within certain areas of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS Section 34 of the Planning Act, S.O. 1983, as amended, provides that the governing body of a Municipal Corporation may pass by-laws to regulate the use of lands and the character, location and use of buildings and structures;

AND WHEREAS the Planning & Development Committee of the Town of Pelham has recommended that such a by-law be enacted;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham has deemed it to be in the public interest that such a by-law be enacted;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That the lands identified on Schedule A attached hereto and forming part of this by-law are hereby zoned Agricultural "A-82" Zone.

(2) <u>Agricultural "A-82" Zone</u>

Subject to the general provisions of Section 6 of By-Law #1136 (1987) and all other applicable requirements and sections of By-Law #1136 (1987), the provisions of this section shall apply throughout the Agricultural "A-82" Zone.

(2.1) PERMITTED USES

- (A) In addition to the uses permitted in the 'A' zone, nothing in the by-law shall prevent the use of the lands identified as "A-82" for a church.
- (B) Regulations for churches permitted in clause (a) -Permitted Uses

(a)	Minimum	Lot	Area	.5	ha

- (b) Minimum LotFrontage 60m
- (c) Maximum Lot Frontage 20%
- (d) Minimum Front Yard 20m from the centre line of the road
- (e) Minimum Side Yard 9m
- (f) Minimum Rear Yard 9m
- (g) Maximum Building Height 10.5m

(3) THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect pursuant to Sections 34(19) and 34(31) of the Planning Act, S.O. 1983.
