BY-LAW NO. 1315 (1990)

Being a by-law to appoint a Civic  
Recognition Committee.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and desirable to appoint a Civic Recognition Committee to assist Council in the selection of citizens of the Town of Pelham for civic recognition, who have achieved Provincial, National or International recognition as well as those who have significantly contributed to some aspect of the life of the local community;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1)                THAT a Committee to be known as "The Civic Recognition Committee" be created.

(2)                THAT the Committee shall consist of six (6) members to be comprised of:

- three (3) members of the public to be appointed by Council
- one (1) member of the Sports Council to be appointed by the Sports Council
- two (2) members of the Council of the Town of Pelham

(3)                THAT the qualifications for consideration of recognition by the Committee shall be -

(a)                Those achieving Ontario, National or International Recognition and in so doing have brought honour to the Town.

(b)                Those, who in the view of the Civic Recognition Committee, through honourable endeavours have brought favourable publicity, honour and/or have added considerably to the quality of life within the community.

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(4) THAT Council may make such policies as it deems necessary for the guidance of the Committee.

(5) THAT the appointments to the Committee shall be for the same term as the term of office for the Municipal Council.

(6) THAT the Clerk Administrator or designate shall act as Secretary to the Committee.
