BY-LAW NO. 1345 (1990)

Being a by-law to authorize the purchase  
of certain lands for a municipal parking  
lot.

WHEREAS Section 208 (55) of the Municipal Act  
authorizes the Council of a municipality to acquire,  
establish, layout and improve lands, buildings and  
structures for or in connection with the parking of  
vehicles;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the  
Town of Pelham deems it necessary and desirable to acquire  
lands in the former police village of Fenwick for the  
purposes of improving the public parking facilities;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF  
THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the lands municipally known as "1139 Maple  
Street" and being Part of Lot 1, Plan 16 (N.K.A. 703) be  
purchased for the purposes of a parking lot at a cost of  
Eighty-Two Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$82,500.00) from  
the Estate of Myles Everett Stickles.

(2) THAT the costs of the land purchase and any costs  
associated therewith shall be paid from the Town of Pelham  
Impost Reserve Fund.
