BY-LAW NO. 1351 (1990)

Being a by-law to accept certain lands  
for the purposes of a public highway and  
to name the public highway.

WHEREAS the Council of every Corporation may pass  
by-laws for acquiring any lands required for the purpose of  
the Corporation;

AND WHEREAS the Council of a local Municipality  
may pass by-laws for establishing and laying out highways:

AND WHEREAS the Council of a local Municipality  
may pass by-laws to name highways or change their names:

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the  
Town of Pelham deems it desirable to accept certain lands  
for the purpose of a public highway and name such public  
highway.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF  
THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


(1)            THAT the lands as described in Schedule "A"  
attached hereto be acquired for the purposes of a public  
highway by acceptance of the conveyance from the Executors  
of the Estate of Elsie Iantha Sibbett.

(2)            THAT Part 3 as shown on Reference Plan 59R-4358 be  
and is hereby dedicated for the use of the public as a  
public highway.

(3)            THAT the public highway as described in Section 2  
of this By-law be named Brookfield Court.
