THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN O F PELH AM BY-LAW #1398 (1991)

Being a by-law to change the name of a street in the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS Section 210 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, provides that by-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities for changing the names of highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham deems it desirable and necessary to change the name of a street in the Town of Pelham in order to eliminate a duplication of street names which has existed;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT "ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Pelham, Regional Municipality of Niagara, formerly the Village of Fonthill, Township of Pelham, County of Welland, and being composed of Part of Church Street according to Registered Plan 25 for the said Village of Fonthill, now known as Plan 717 for the Town of Pelham more particularly defined as follows:

All that portion of Church Street, lying east of the east limit of The King's Highway No. 20 and west of the west limit of Canboro Road, bounded on the north by part of Blocks T and J and on the south by part of Lot 83 all according to said Plan 717 for the Town of Pelham.

SECONDLY: All that portion of Church Street lying east of the east limit of Canboro Road and west of the west limit of South Pelham Street, bounded on the north by Lots 3 to 12 inclusive and Lot 6 (on the west side of South Pelham Street) and bounded on the south by Lots 68, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 77, 78, 79, 80, 81 and Part of Block G all according to said Plan 717 for the Town of Pelham" be and are hereby named "CHURCH HILL".

THAT this by-law shall come into force and effect upon (2) the registration of the by-law in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Niagara South.
