Health and Safety program.


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham realizes that it has the responsibility to provide a safe work environment for its' employees, that each employee must pursue the highest standards in his or her assigned activities, that all municipal employees must recognize that the well-being of persons involved and the protection of our physical resources are as important as the activity and work being performed and that no job is so important that safety does not come first.


AND whereas the Occupational Health and Safety Act R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 321 as amended provides that an employer must prepare and review, at least annually, a written occupational health and safety policy and develop and maintain a program to implement that policy.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1)        THAT the Municipal Health and Safety Policy attached as Schedule "A" to this by-law be and is hereby adopted.
