BY-LAW NO. 1422 (1991)

Being a by-law to establish a lower speed limit on
Quaker Road between Haist Street and Welland Road

WHEREAS Subsection 2 of Section 109 of the Highway
Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 198 provides that the
Council of a municipality and the trustees of a police
village may by by-law prescribe a higher or lower rate of
speed for motor vehicles driven on any highway or portion
of a highway under its jurisdiction than is prescribed in
Subsection 1 of Section 109;


AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and desirable
that the speed limit for motor vehicles on certain
highways in the municipality of the Town of Pelham be
decreased;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT Schedule "W" of By-law #89-2000 be amended as
set out on Schedule "A" attached hereto.

(2) THAT this by-law shall not become effective until
approved by the Council of the Regional Municipality of
Niagara and signs are erected.
