

THE CORPORATION OF THE

BY-LAW NO. 1431 (1991)

Being a by-law to provide for  
payment of the Council Stipends.

WHEREAS Section 238 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, provides that Council of the municipality may pass by-laws for paying the members of the Council, such annual allowance Council may determine;

AND WHEREAS Section 239 of the said Municipal Act provides that a portion of the annual allowance may be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of Council;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1)            THAT the Mayor of the Council be paid the sum of \$10,000.00 be annum and 1/3 (one-third) of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of her duties.

(2)            THAT the Alderman of Council be paid an annual allowance of \$5,600.00 and 1/3 (one-third) of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of their duties.

(3)            THAT the remuneration provided by this by-law shall be paid as follows:

(i) Alderman of Council shall be paid quarterly in the months of February, May, August and November.

(ii) Mayor of Council shall be paid bi-weekly at the same time as the full time staff members of the municipality are paid.

(4) THAT the rate of remuneration for the Mayor and Aldermen, as set out above, shall be effective as of December 1st., 1991.

(5) THAT By-law #1227 (1988) of the Town of Pelham be and the same is hereby repealed.
