BY-LAW NO. 1433 (1991)

WHEREAS Section 45 (1) of the Municipal Elections Act R.S.O. 1980, as amended, provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law passed prior to the first day of October in an election year, authorize the use of composite ballots at a municipal election;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and advisable to use a composite ballot;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the use of a composite ballot be authorized for use in the 1991 municipal election.

(2) THAT the composite ballot shall, subject to subsections 43 (1) to (8) contain the names of candidates for the offices of Mayor, and member of Regional Council, member of Council, member of the Niagara South Board of Education and member of the Welland County Roman Catholic Separate School Board and any by-law or question authorized or required by law to be submitted to the electors for their assent or opinion.
