## THE CORPORATION OF THE

## TOWN OF PELHAM

## BY-LAW #1446 (1991)

Being a by-law to change the name of a highway forming part of the northern boundary between the Town of Lincoln and the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Council deems it necessary and expedient to change the name of the street or highway shown in Column 1 on Schedule "A" affixed hereto and forming part of this by-law to the name shown in Column 3 of the said schedule. In order to eliminate a duplication of names in the Town of Lincoln.

Paragraph 105 of Section 210 of the Municipal Act provides that by-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities "to provide for surveying, settling and marking the boundary lines of highways and giving names to them or changing their names, and for affixing the names at the corners thereof, on public or private property.

- (a) A by-law changing the name of a highway has no effect until a copy of it, certified under the hand of the Clerk and the seal of the Corporation, has been registered in the proper Land Registry Office.
- (b) Before passing a by-law for changing the name of a highway:
  - (i) notice of the proposed by-law shall be published at least once a week for four successive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality, and
  - (ii) the Council shall hear any person who claims that he will be adversely affected by the by-law and who applied to be heard.

Notice of the proposed by-law was published in the November 13th, November 20th, November 28th, and December 4th., 1991 issue of the Pelham Herald, a weekly newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality and a copy of the said notice is shown on Schedule "B" to this by-law.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) Upon the passing of this by-law and following the registration of a copy thereof by the Clerk in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Niagara South, the street or highway currently named as shown in Column 1 of Schedule "A" affixed hereto and forming part of this by-law shall be renamed as shown in Column 3 of the said schedule and shall be signed accordingly.
