THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW NO. 1470 (1992)

Being a by-law to appoint a Chief Building Official/By-law Enforcement Officer.

WHEREAS authority is granted, pursuant to subsection 2 of Section 3 of the Building Code Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter B.13 as amended to municipal councils to appoint a Chief Building Official for the purposes of the enforcement of the Building Code and to Regulations thereunder;

AND WHEREAS authority is granted pursuant to Section 15 of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15 to municipal councils to appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality who shall be peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws;

AND WHEREAS authority is granted pursuant to Section 31 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13 for an officer to enforce a property standards by-law passed by the council of a municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That Ernie Cronier is hereby appointed as Chief Building Official for the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.
- (2) That the Chief Building Official shall be responsible for the enforcement of the Building Code Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter B.13 as amended, and the Regulations thereunder.
- (3) That **Ernie Cronier** is hereby appointed as Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer and Property Standards Officer for the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.
- (4) That the Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer and Property Standards Officer shall be responsible for the enforcement of all by-laws passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham.

CON'T....

That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on (5) the 4th. day of May, 1992 and shall supercede all previous by-laws to appoint a Chief Building Official.
