BY-LAW NO. 1481 (1992)

Being a by-law to provide for the erection of
stop signs at intersections.

WHEREAS Section 137 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O.
1990, Chapter H.8 provides that the Council of a municipality may
by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections
on highways under its jurisdiction and every stop sign so erected
shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN
OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT Schedule "P" of By-law #89-2000 be amended as set
out on Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- (2) THAT each designation made by Section (1) shall not
become effective until said signs have been erected in accordance
with the regulations of the Highway Traffic Act.
- (3) THAT this by-law shall not become effective until
approved by the Council of the Regional Municipality of Niagara.
