

THE CORPORATION OF THE  
TOWN OF PELHAM  
BY-LAW #1489 (1992)

Being a by-law to authorize the purchase of  
certain lands for recreational purposes.

WHEREAS Section 207 (58) of the **Municipal Act** Chapter M.45,  
authorizes the Council of a municipality to acquire athletic fields;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of  
Pelham deems it necessary and desirable to acquire lands in the former police  
Village of Fenwick for the purposes of improving recreation facilities;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE  
TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


(1) THAT a portion of the lands municipally known as "963 Church  
Street" and being Part of Lot 8 (ES Church Street), Plan 16 (N.K.A. 703), now in the  
Town of Pelham, designated as Part 4 on Reference Plan 59R-7488, be purchased  
for recreational purposes at a cost of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) from  
Mr. Jack Rosinski.

(2) THAT the costs of the land purchase and any costs associated  
therewith shall be paid from the "Town of Pelham Parks Fund."

(3) THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to  
sign the necessary documents to complete the property acquisition.
