

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 149 (1972)

A by-law for the submission to a vote on certain questions to the qualified electors under the provisions of Section 73 (1) of the Liquor Licence Act, R. S. O. 1970, c. 250 in that part of the Town of Pelham formerly the Corporation of the Village of Fonthill.

AND WHEREAS by Section 85 of the Liquor Licence Act it is provided that no annexation shall affect the operation of the Liquor Licence Act at the time of the annexation in the area annexed until such operation has been affected pursuant to a vote under the Liquor Licence Act in the area so annexed.

AND WHEREAS under Section 73 (1) of the Liquor Licence Act the Council of the municipality may submit to a vote of the persons qualified to be entered on the voters' list and to vote at Elections to the Assembly in the municipality or a portion thereof any questions set forth in the Liquor Licence Act.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of Pelham in the Regional Municipality of Niagara, is the Council having jurisdiction over the aforesaid area in which the aforesaid by-law was in force.

AND WHEREAS the said Council deems it expedient and desirable to submit to a vote of the persons qualified to vote thereon as aforesaid, the following questions:

Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a dining lounge licence for consumption on licensed premises with food available?

Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a lounge licence for consumption on licensed premises?

AND WHEREAS the Council has requested the Liquor Licence Board to fix a day for the taking of the vote on the said questions, the Board has fixed Monday the 4th day of December, 1972.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to provide by by-law for the submission of the said questions to the persons qualified to vote thereon and for the taking of their votes thereon.

THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham, in the Regional Municipality of Niagara, enacts as follows:

1. Under the Liquor Licence Act there is hereby submitted to a vote of the persons qualified to be entered on the voters' list and to vote at Elections to the Assembly in that part of the municipality annexed from the area formerly known as the Corporation of the Village of Fonthill now forming part of the Town of Pelham, in the Regional Municipality of Niagara, the following questions:

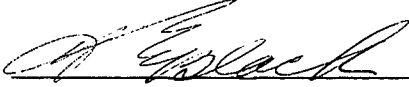
Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a dining lounge licence for consumption on licensed premises with food available?

Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a lounge licence for consumption on licensed premises?

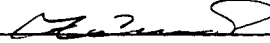
2. The vote shall be taken on Monday the 4th day of December, 1972, as directed by the Liquor Licence Board of Ontario and in accordance with the provisions of the Liquor Licence Act.

3. This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the day of final passing thereof.

FINALLY PASSED this 2nd day of October, 1972.



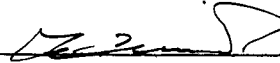
