Municipal Blue Box programs get funding extension

Environment and Energy Minister Bud Wildman confirmed today that no municipality will lose provincial support for its Blue Box recycling programs between now and March 1996.

Provincial funding support to 141 municipal Blue Box programs was due to expire on March 31, 1994. Funding eligibility for a further 200 municipalities was also scheduled to end two years later.

All of these municipalities will now continue to be eligible for funding support up to March 31, 1996.

"The government is committed to helping communities maintain their Blue Box recycling programs, which have proven to be not only highly popular but also very successful when it comes to diverting waste from landfill," said Mr. Wildman.

The Ministry of Environment and Energy provides funding support to municipalities to develop and operate recycling programs under the Municipal Recycling Support Program.

Mr. Wildman indicated that the current funding extension is only a short-term measure.

"In the coming months I will be announcing a long-term arrangement that will secure more private sector funding for municipal Blue Box programs," said Mr. Wildman.

More than three million homes in Ontario participate in 520 municipal Blue Box programs across the province. Approximately 440,000 tonnes of waste annually are diverted from disposal to productive uses.
