

THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW #1628 (1994)

Being a by-law to stop up, close and sell
an original road allowance, municipally
known as "Envoy Street" as shown on
Registered Plan #24 (N.K.A. Plan #711).

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Pelham, hereinafter called the "Corporation", that the original road allowance set out and described in Schedule "A" attached hereto be closed and stopped up and sold to the adjoining land owners;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Pelham Herald, a newspaper published weekly in the Town of Pelham;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


(1) THAT upon and after the passing of this by-law the road allowance set out and described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, be and the same is hereby closed and stopped up.

(2) THAT all that part of the said road allowance herein before described and stopped up shall be sold to the adjoining owner or owners or any of them.

(3) THAT the Mayor & Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham are hereby authorized to sign or execute such deeds or other documents as may be necessary to affect conveyance of that part of the said road allowance hereinbefore described and which has been stopped up and closed.
