

THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM
BY-LAW #1665 (1994)

Being a by-law to provide for payment of Council Stipends.


WHEREAS Section 242 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 provides that Council of the municipality may pass by-laws for paying remuneration to the members of Council and that such remuneration may be determined in any manner Council considers advisable;

AND WHEREAS Section 243 of the said Municipal Act provides that a portion of the annual remuneration may be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of Council;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the Mayor of the Council be paid an annual remuneration of \$11,200.00 and that 1/3 (one-third) of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of their duties.
- (2) THAT the Alderman of the Council be paid an annual remuneration of \$5,600.00 and that 1/3 (one-third) of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of their duties.
- (3) THAT the remuneration provided for by this by-law shall be paid as follows:
 - (i) Mayor of Council shall be paid bi-weekly at the same time as the full time staff members of the municipality are paid.
 - (ii) Alderman of Council shall be paid quarterly in the months of February, May, August and November.
- (4) THAT the rate of remuneration for the Mayor and Alderman, as set out above, shall be effective as of December 1st., 1994.
- (5) THAT By-law #1431 (1991) be and the same is hereby repealed.
