

THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM
BY-LAW #1742 (1995)

Being a by-law to provide for payment of Council Stipends.

WHEREAS Section 242 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 provides that Council of the municipality may pass by-laws for paying remuneration to the members of Council and that such remuneration may be determined in any manner Council considers advisable;

AND WHEREAS Section 243 of the said Municipal Act provides that a portion of the annual remuneration may be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of Council;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the Mayor of the Council be paid an annual remuneration of \$15,831.00 and that 1/3 (one-third) of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of the Mayor's duties.

(2) THAT the Councillors of the Council be paid an annual remuneration of \$7,124.00 and that 1/3 (one-third) of the amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of their duties.

(3) THAT the remuneration provided for by this by-law shall be paid as follows:

(i) Mayor of Council shall be paid bi-weekly at the same time as the full time staff members of the municipality are paid.

(ii) Councillors of Council shall be paid quarterly in the months of February, May, August and November.

(4) THAT the rate of remuneration for the Mayor and Councillors, as set out above, shall be phased in over a three year period as follows:




(5) THAT commencing in 1998 Council increases its rate of compensation yearly at the same rate as economic adjustments are awarded to staff of the Town of Pelham.

(6) THAT mileage only be paid to Town of Pelham Council members for travel outside of the Niagara Region.

(7) THAT By-law #1665 (1994) be and the same is hereby repealed.
