BY-LAW NO. 1757 (1995)

Being a by-law to provide for the erection of  
stop signs at intersections.

WHEREAS Section 137 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8 provides that the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction and every stop sign so erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1)            THAT Schedule "P" of By-law #89-2000 be amended as set out on Schedule "A" attached hereto.

(2)            THAT each designation made by Section (1) shall not become effective until said signs have been erected in accordance with the regulations of the Highway Traffic Act.

(3)            THAT this by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Council of the Regional Municipality of Niagara.
