

THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM
BY-LAW #1832 (1996)

Being a by-law to delegate to the Regional Municipality of Niagara Police Services Board the power to license, regulate and govern security alarm businesses.

WHEREAS Section 257.2 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, as amended, provides that the Council of a local municipality may pass by-laws for the licensing, regulating and governing of any business carried on within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 257.4 of the Municipal Act provides that the Council of a city/town may pass a by-law to delegate to the Police Services Board the power to license, regulate and govern a business specified in the by-law for all or that part of the city/town over which the Police Services Board has jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS Section 257.6 of the Municipal Act provides that Part XVII.1 of the Act applies to local municipalities in the exercise of any power to pass by-laws licensing businesses under any other section of the Municipal Act or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham wishes to delegate the authority to license security alarm businesses for all of the Town to the Police Services Board;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) The authority of the Town of Pelham to license, regulate and govern security alarm businesses for all of the municipality pursuant to Section 257.2 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, as amended, is hereby delegated to the Regional Municipality of Niagara Police Services Board.

(2) This by-law comes into force on the 3rd. day of September, 1996.
