

THE CORPORATION OF THE

BY-LAW #186 (1973)

Being a by-law to authorize the construction of a watermain extension in the Port Robinson Road Area of the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS by Section 2, Paragraph (1) (e) of the Local Improvement Act, Chapter 255, R.S.O. 1970, Councils of local municipalities are empowered to undertake the constructing, enlarging or extending of a watermain as a local improvement;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and advisable to construct the watermain extensions on Port Robinson Road as set out in Schedule "B" attached hereto

AND WHEREAS the said watermain extension is to serve an area within "The Fonhill Water Works Area" established by By-law #128 (1971) finally passed on the 16th. day of July A.D., 1973;

AND WHEREAS a sufficiently signed petition has been presented to the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham for the above described construction;

AND WHEREAS the Town Engineer's Report, dated July 13th., 1973 and attached hereto as Schedule "A", indicates the construction is estimated to cost \$22,100.00;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a by-law of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham as follows:

1. THAT the Town of Pelham construct the Port Robinson Road watermain extension on Port Robinson Road at a total estimated cost of \$22,100.00;
2. THAT the Town of Pelham authorize the Town Engineer to prepare engineering drawings and specifications and call tenders for the construction of the said watermain extension and all appurtenances;
3. THAT the Town of Pelham do prepare a special assessment roll to levy a per-foot frontage charge on all abutting properties as recommended by the said Town Engineer's Report.
4. THAT the Treasurer, subject to the approval of Council may agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to

5. THAT application be made to the Council of the Regional Municipality of Niagara to borrow money for the said purposes and to issue debentures therefor on the credit of the Regional Corporation;

6. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon receipt of the formal Ontario Municipal Board approval.
