THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 1863(1996)

Being a by-law to amend Zoning By-Law No. 1136(1987), as amended.

WHEREAS Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, provides that the governing body of a municipal corporation may pass by-laws to regulate the use of lands and the character, location and use of buildings and structures;

AND WHEREAS the Planning Services Division of General Committee of the Town of Pelham has recommended that such a by-law be enacted;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham has deemed it to be in the public interest that such a by-law be enacted;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the lands identified on Schedule "A" attached hereto be and are hereby re-zoned from a Highway Commercial HC Zone to a Highway Commercial HC-135 Zone.
- (2) THAT Section 30 Exceptions of By-Law No. 1136(1987) is amended by adding thereto the following exception:
 - "HC-135" In addition to the permitted uses of the Highway Commercial HC Zone, nothing in this by-law shall prevent the use of the lands indicated as HC-135 on Schedule A to this by-law for a ground floor single dwelling unit and uses, buildings and structures accessory thereto, and the following special regulations shall apply thereto:
 - a) Minimum Front Yard

13.0 m

b) Planting Strip

Not required for westerly 42 metres of lot frontage

c) Parking Area Location

No setback required for westerly

42 metres of lot frontage

Minimum Driveway Width

4.27 m

e) Minimum Number of Parking Spaces for the manufacturing

and retailing of wine

5

f) Minimum Number of Loading Spaces for the manufacturing

None

and retailing of wine

THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect pursuant to Section 34(21) and (3) 34(30) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
