BY-LAW NO. 1867 (1997)

Being a by-law to authorize the purchase from the Regional Municipality of Niagara those lands more particularly described in Schedule "A".


WHEREAS Section 191 (1) of the Municipal Act, Chapter M.45, R.S.O. 1990 provides that the Council of every corporation may pass by-laws for acquiring any land required for the purposes of the corporation;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it desirable to purchase certain lands from the Regional Municipality of Niagara;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the lands more particularly described in Schedule "A" be purchased from the Regional Municipality of Niagara at a cost of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00).
- (2) THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute all documents required to complete the purchase of the subject lands.
