

THE CORPORATION OF THE

T O W N O F P E L H A M

BY-LAW #188 (1973)

Being a by-law to establish a plan for the co-ordination of municipal and regional services and certain volunteer agencies in the event of floods, hurricanes, windstorms, blizzards, landslides, explosions, aircraft or rail crash, toxic or flammable gas escapes, building or structure collapse, uncontrollable fires or any other emergency, or the threat of any of the foregoing.

WHEREAS Section 242 of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, states: "Every Council may pass such By-laws and make such regulations for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality in matters not specifically provided for by this Act as may be deemed expedient.."

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to ensure by prior arrangement the efficient co-ordination of municipal and regional services and certain volunteer agencies for operations to provide for the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Pelham in the event of emergency situations or the threat of such situations occurring.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In the event of, or a threat of, a flood, hurricane, windstorm, blizzard, landslide, explosion, aircraft or rail crash, toxic or flammable gas escape, building or structure collapse, uncontrollable fire or any other emergency within the boundaries of the Town of Pelham or nearby so as to affect the inhabitants of the Town of Pelham, the Town of Pelham Plan for Peacetime Disasters, a copy of which is attached hereto and which forms "Schedule "A" to this By-law shall come into effect forthwith.

2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon being passed by Council.

READ A FIRST TIME this 16 day of July, 1973.

READ A SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED this 16th day of July, 1973.
