BY-LAW NO. 1915 (1997)

Being a by-law to provide for the use of alternative voting
methods

WHEREAS Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, provides that a municipal council may at least sixty days prior to voting day, pass a by-law authorizing electors to use an alternative voting method, such as voting by mail or by telephone, that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the use of telephone as an alternative voting method is hereby authorized in respect of the municipal election to be held in 1997.
- (2) THAT the procedures contained in Section 43 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, dealing with advance votes apply and the procedures contained in Section 44 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, dealing with voting proxies do not apply.
