TER OF TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATIONS

Being a by-law to prohibit the passage over
and use of O'Reilly's Bridge to motor vehicles
having a gross weight, including load exceeding
three tons.

WHEREAS Section 64 (8) of the Highway Traffic Act provides

that the municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over
a bridge may by by-law approved by the Department make regulations limit-
ing the gross weight of any vehicle or combination of vehicles or any class
thereof passing over such bridge,

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Pelham and the
Corporation of the Township of Wainfleet, have joint jurisdiction over
a bridge over the Welland River, known as O'Reilly's Bridge,

AND WHEREAS it appears by virtue of the present aging condition
of the said bridge that motor vehicles having a gross weight, including load
in excess of three tons, should be prohibited from passage over and use of
the said bridge,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham
to hereby jointly with the Council of the Township of Wainfleet, to
cise its' authority and responsibility to so limit the use of said bridge
d passage of vehicles thereon to those having a gross weight, including
load, not exceeding three tons and to prohibit all others.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF

PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. All vehicles including motor vehicles having a gross weight,
including load thereon, exceeding three tons, shall be and the same are
hereby prohibited from the passage over and use of O'Reilly's Bridge.

2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the
passage by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wainfleet of
a by-law of the similar nature to and having the same effect as this by-law.
