THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 1958 (1997)

Being a by-law to amend By-law No. 1034 (1985) being a by-law to prescribe the height and description of lawful fences.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT Subsection 6 (a) be added to By-law No. 1034 (1985) as follows:

 "6 (a) Notwithstanding Section 6 above, a fence may be erected or caused to be erected or maintained or caused to be maintained to a height no greater than 1.82m (6′-0") above the centre line of Pelham Street in any rear yard of those lots adjacent to the westerly boundary of Pelham Street from the intersection of Merritt Road and Pelham Street to the north side of Welland Road at its intersection with Pelham Street."
- 2. THAT Section 11 to By-law No. 1034 (1985) be deleted and the following substituted therefore,
 - "11. Any person who contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a penalty as prescribed by the Provincial Offences Act"
