THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 2026 (1998)

Being a by-law to dedicate Part of Parcel 59-3, Section 59M-218, designated as Part 4 on Reference Plan 59R-10283 as a public highway and to name the lands "Milliner Place" and to dedicate Part of Parcel 59-3, Section 59M-218, designated as Parts 9 and 10 on Reference Plan 59R-10283 as a public highway and to name the lands "Wellington Court"

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it desirable and necessary to dedicate, as a public highway, the lands herein described and to name the lands "Milliner Place" and "Wellington Court";

AND WHEREAS the said lands are situated in the Town of Pelham;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT Part of Parcel 59-3, Section 59M-128, designated as Part 4 on Reference Plan 59R-10283 be dedicated for the use of the public as a public highway;
- (2) THAT the public highway described in Section (1) be named "MILLINER PLACE".
- (3) THAT Part of Parcel 59-3, Section 59M-218, designated as Parts 9 and 10 on Reference Plan 59R-10283 be dedicated for the use of the public as a public highway;
- (4) THAT the public highway described in Section (3) be named "WELLINGTON COURT".
- (5) THAT this by-law shall come into force and effect upon the registration of the by-law in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Niagara South.
