THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW #2057 (1999)

Being a by-law to rescind By-law #2050 (1998), being a by-law to provide coverage for volunteer firefighters.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham on December 14th., 1998 enacted a by-law to provide certain coverage for volunteer firefighters pending the passing of legislation which would amend the Workplace Safety & Insurance Act, 1997;

AND WHEREAS Bill 92 - Emergency Volunteers Protection Act, 1998 was introduced by the Honourable J. Flaherty, Minister of Labour on December 3rd., 1998 to amend the Workplace Safety & Insurance Act, 1997 to reinstate the provisions that the municipality sets the amount of earnings, subject to a maximum, to be attributed to each member of a municipal volunteer fire brigade and to recognize a member of a municipal volunteer fire brigade as an emergency worker;

AND WHEREAS notification has now been received that Bill 92 - Emergency Volunteers Protection Act, 1998 received Royal Assent on December 18th., 1998;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT By-law #2050 (1998), being a by-law to provide coverage for volunteer firefighters be rescinded.
