BY-LAW #219 (1973)

Being a by-law to establish a 40 mph. speed limit on Welland Road.

WHEREAS Subsection (5) of Section 82 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 202 authorizes the Council of a city, town or village and the trustees of a police village may by by-law prescribe a higher rate of speed for motor vehicles driven on any highway or portion of a highway under its jurisdiction than is prescribed in Subsection (1) but such increased rate of speed shall not be more than 60 miles per hour,

AND WHEREAS, the statutory speed limit on Welland Road is 30 miles per hour under the Highway Traffic Act,

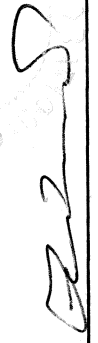
AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the speed limit for motor vehicles on certain highways in the Municipality of Pelham be either decreased or increased or both;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) When any highway or portion of highway set out in Schedule "A", hereto is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be the rate of speed prescribed in the schedule
- (2) The penalties provided in Subsection (2) of Section 117 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.
- (3) This by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Ministry of Transportation & Communications.
