THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW NO. 2182 (2000)

Being a by-law to provide for the use of voting and vote-counting equipment.

WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act*, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may at least sixty days prior to voting day, pass a by-law authorizing the use of voting and vote counting equipment;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) The use of vote-counting equipment is hereby authorized in respect of the municipal election to be held in 2000 and in subsequent elections.
- (2) The use of Accu-Vote Optical Scan Voting System as an alternative voting method, is hereby authorized in respect of the municipal election to be held in 2000 and in subsequent elections.
