BY-LAW NO. 2251 (2001)

Being a by-law to reimpose part lot control upon certain lands in the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it expedient that the said by-law be repealed; and

WHEREAS Section 50(7) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, provides that by-laws exempting certain lands from the part lot control provisions of the Planning Act may be repealed.
