Being a by-law to amend By-law No. 1608 (1993), being a by-law to regulate parks and facilities in the Town of Pelham.

WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and desirable to amend By-law #1608 (1993) as it pertains to approvals for public and private functions on municipally owned properties, as well as the regulation of after hour useage;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT Section 5 (a) (i) of By-law #1608 (1993) be and is hereby deleted and that the following be added in its place: -
 - "remain in or enter any municipally owned or controlled properties, as per Schedule "A", between dusk and dawn, except as a participant or spectator of any function approved by the Corporation;"
- (2) THAT Section 6 (a) (vii) of By-law #1608 (1993) be and is hereby deleted and that the following be added in its place: "Organize or arrange an event, gathering or picnic."
- (3) THAT Schedule "A" to By-law #1608 (1993) be and is hereby deleted and that Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law be appended thereto.
