THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM

BY-LAW NO. 2264 (2001)

Being a by-law to amend Zoning By-law No. 1136 (1987), as amended.

WHEREAS Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, provides that the governing body of a municipal corporation may pass by-laws to regulate the use of lands and the character, location and use of buildings and structures;

AND WHEREAS the General Committee, Planning Services Division of the Town of Pelham has recommended that such a by-law be enacted;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Pelham has deemed it to be in the public interest that such a by-law be enacted;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT the lands identified on Schedule 'A' attached hereto be and are hereby rezoned 1. from an Agricultural "A-141" Zone to a Agricultural "A-159" Zone.
- THAT Section 30 Exceptions of By-Law No. 1136 (1987) is amended by adding thereto 2. the following exception:
 - "A-159 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 7.4 (a) of the Agricultural 'A' Zone the following shall apply:
 - a) Minimum lot frontage 39.6 metres"
- THAT Section 30 Exceptions of By-Law No. 1136(1987) is amended by adding to the 3. special exception "A-141" Zone of amending By-Law No. 1998 (1998) a special provision.
- THAT Section 30 Exceptions of By-law No. 1136 (1987) is amended by adding thereto 4. the following exception:
 - Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 7.2 (a) of the Agricultural 'A' Zone "A-141 the following shall apply
 - f) Minimum lot frontage 100.3 metres"
- 5. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect pursuant to Sections 34(21) and 34(30) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
