

THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM
BY-LAW #2292 (2001)

Being a by-law to authorize the Mayor & Clerk to enter into Incentive Agreements with physicians.

WHEREAS Section 113, Subsection (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 states, in part, that the council of every municipality may, subject to Section 111, make grants, on such terms and conditions as to security and otherwise as the council may consider expedient, to any person, institution, association, group or body of any kind, including a fund, within or outside the boundaries of the municipality for any purpose that, in the opinion of the council, is in the interests of the municipality;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it desirable to enter into Incentive Agreements with physicians who agree to open and operate a practice within the Town of Pelham;


AND WHEREAS approval of Council is required prior to the signing of such incentive agreements by the Mayor and Clerk;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and each of them is hereby authorized and instructed on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham to execute the said Incentive Agreements as approved by Council, from time to time, and the Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
